7 KEYS TO A GREAT VIDEO

- 1. Light check: Make sure the light (lamp, sun, natural light through a window) is in front of you, not behind.
- 2. Sound check: To test the audio, record yourself counting to five and then play it back to check the sound.
- 3. Rest your camera on something steady. Avoid trying to hold your cellphone up in the air in one place for two to three minutes.
- 4. Place your testimony notes next to the camera.
- 5. If you are using your phone, look into the camera lens on the phone and not the video screen.
- 6. Place your phone on airplane mode to avoid social media or incoming text interruptions.
- 7. Relax and smile into the camera before you start.
